Real Closet

Most Closets

Mounting System

Foundation Rails

2 - Foundation rails per partition

Mounted below and above partitions

Solid maple with UV finish to match

Foundation Rails

Mounts on top of Foundation Rail

Clears floor and base moldings

Uneven floors don't matter

Hanging Strip

1 - strip per partition

Fits into a notch in the back of partition

Metal strip covered with a plastic cover

Floor Mount

Mounts on top of floor

Interferes with flooring and base moldings

Must be scribed to fit the floor

Partitions

3/4" Plywood

2 - Foundation metal clips 1-top and 1-bottom

2' and 4' tall expandable to 6' and 8' tall

High pressure melamine laminates

5/8" or 3/4" Particle Board

1 - notch in partition to fit over metal strip

Standard sizes not expandable

Low pressure melamine

Finished Ends

Applied solid maple moldings

"Replicates styles of cabinet doors"

Standard partitions without holes

Shelving

3/4" Plywood 18", 24" and 30" widths

Twin Beam Shelving 18", 24", 30", 35", and 47"

Shoe shelf rails are part of the shelf

Shelf edge is solid maple with UV finish

High pressure melamine laminate surface

All clips fit into shelves making them solid

5/8" or 3/4" Particle Board 18"- 30"widths

An additional accessory to purchase

1 - Mill thickness plastic edge banding

Low pressure melamine surface

Shelves sit on top of clips loosely and can pull out

Drawers

Profiled solid maple drawer fronts

Dovetailed prefinished solid birch

Full extension self - centering glides

Vinyl covered particle board

Doweled or stapled particle board

3/4 Extension standard glide
